- 1. I'll never forget when I heard this once at a men's conference...
- 2. What do we mean by "the gospel"?

"Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, and by which you are being saved...For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures." – 1 Cor.15:1-4

- 3. To understand the importance of the gospel, let's get in a spiritual time machine and go back to the beginning.
  - a. Why did God create us?

"[God the Father] chose us in [Christ] before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him." ~ Ephesians 1:4

- c. Why is the world the way it is? The Christian answer has two strands of evidence supporting it.

Jesus came to earth to	us how to live rightly.
Jesus died on the cross to give us the	to live rightly.
Jesus rose from the grave to give us the	to live rightly

➤ He came to teach us how to live rightly.

"Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." ~

Matthew 24:35

That Jesus has to teach us says a couple important things:

- ➤ He died to give us the power to live rightly.

  "But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed." ~ Isajah 53:5
  - a. What did Adam and Eve have that we don't?
  - b. How did Jesus' death begin to restore these conditions?
- ➤ He rose to give us the reason to live rightly.
  "You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body." ~ 1 Cor.6:19-20

Paul is urging us to use "gospel thinking". What is this?
