1 Corinthians 12:1, 4-11

1Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be uninformed... 4Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; 5 and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; 6and

there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. 7To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 8For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, 9to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one indi-

1 Corinthians 12:15-17, 21-22

15 If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," that would not make it any less a part of the body. 16And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," that would

not make it any less a part of the body. 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? ... 21The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." 220n the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable."
