## A Quiet Time In Jonah 1



Step One: Observation ~ What do I see?

Observations: A word, a phrase, an action, something repeated, who/what/when/where/why – all may lead to worthwhile insights

## Step Two: Interpretation ~ What does it mean?

Ask questions – What was the author saying to his original readers? Is there anything difficult to understand? What would I like to know more about? Can the passage be interpreted in different ways?

What questions does Jonah 1 bring to mind?



## Step Three: Application ~ What should I do about it?

- B. What truths does this passage teach me about me (or more generally about human nature)?
